

300 Club Frequently Asked Questions

Here are some answers to the Frequently Asked Questions about this new honor:

- What activities count toward 300 Club hours?
 - Voluntary service in which the primary intent is to aid and assist others (not including immediate family members) for the good of the community. These activities should promote the values incorporated in the Stevenson High School Vision and Values Statement.

- Do activities done during the school day count?
 - No. Activities must be done outside the school day or during unscheduled time. In addition, compensation (including grades, class credit and money) can not be provided for eligible service work.

- Are FMP, Giveathon or Class Board hours eligible for 300 Club recognition?
 - Yes, but only hours served during free periods or after school will be recognized.

- Are National Honor Society or religious organization service hours eligible for 300 Club recognition?
 - Yes, as long as the hours meet the aforementioned requirements.

- Who keeps track of the hours?
 - Each student must keep track of their hours except for G.I.V.E. hours which will be in a school database.

- When should students get verification forms signed?
 - It is recommended that each student get the forms signed as each volunteer activity is completed.

- Where can students get the forms and applications?
 - Students should get the forms off of the Student Activities website at <http://www6.district125.k12.il.us/clubs/300/> or from the Student Activities Office.

- How will 300 Club honorees be recognized?
 - Students who meet the 300 Club requirements will be honored at their Commencement ceremony by wearing special white tassels on their mortar boards.
