

## Citing On-line Databases and Web Sites for Works Cited Page (MLA Ver. 7)

January 2010

**Note:** Adding the URL is now optional in MLA 7. We do it here so you know what to use if it is required by your teacher. If it is not, place a period after the date of access. We suggest adding it for general web sites. Also, citations should be double-spaced in your paper. We single space to provide more samples.

**Example:** Author's Last Name, First Name. "Title of Work." *Article's original source*. Vol. Issue Publication date: Page numbers. *Name of database within electronic source*. Product name of electronic source. Date researcher visited site <Electronic Address (URL) of the source>.
